



The Lumberyard main entrance brings the visitor past the saloon and common bathrooms to stairs leading to the train and SkyDecks, and a gallery hall of display bay windows and siding re-purposed from a 1904 house in the historic district. The end of the gallery hall leads to a fountain being donated by Clay Dog Design at the foot of the train in the pre-civil war rock wall salvaged from the Meridian St. construction. 120-D, a new boutique rental space, borders the right side of the hall.
